



Teaching Assistantship Application

Teaching Assistants must be full-time (enrolled in at least 9-credit hours) graduate students and available to work on campus during the day and possibly early evenings. Funding for Teaching Assistantships are given to students taking classes to fulfill a graduate degree only.

Deadline for applying is March 15 for both fall and spring assistantships.

Option 1: Teaching Assistant (TA)	Option 2: Teaching Assistant with Stipend (TAS)
Provides nine (9)-credit hours of tuition in exchange for 10 hours per week of work with a College of Education professor and/or project as assigned by the College of Education Graduate Studies Office.	Provides nine (9)-credit hours of tuition plus a small stipend (approximately \$5000 across academic year) in exchange for 20 hours per week of work with a College of Education professor and/or project as assigned by the College of Education Graduate Studies Office.
